Job Summary:

Greentown Labs, the largest climatetech startup incubator in North America, [is expanding to Houston in 2021](#) to be the first climatetech-focused incubator in the city and serve as an on-the-ground catalyst for climate action in Houston. Greentown Labs is hiring a dynamic, mission-oriented, self-starter Community Manager to oversee and manage Houston's rapidly growing community of cleantech and climate-oriented startups. This person will foster and curate Greentown Houston's community programming to suit and exceed the needs of its startups, ensuring the incubator experience is valuable and impactful for each member. We expect this position to be fully virtual until the new incubator location opens in Spring 2021 in Houston's Innovation District.

The Community Manager is responsible for startup membership management which includes, but is not limited to, fielding member questions and requests, anticipating needs and identifying new resources for Greentown members, facilitating introductions to relevant mentors, encouraging and facilitating connections among our member community, and proactively providing services and resources to our members as they grow their businesses. The Community manager will also actively promote members and the community through social media platforms, media, and on site tours. To be successful in this highly collaborative role, the Community Manager must work seamlessly with the entire Greentown team, across both locations, to ensure top-notch customer service for our member community. The right candidate will be a creative thinker, enthusiastic networker, and detail-oriented project manager with a passion for supporting early-stage, climatetech entrepreneurs. This position will report directly to the Community Director located at Greentown's headquarters in Somerville, Massachusetts, but be physically located in Houston, TX.

Primary Responsibilities of the Role:

Community Engagement

- Work with the Greentown team to build a supportive community and incubation space for climate and cleantech startups in Houston and liaise with Houston ecosystem organizations and other relevant regional startup support organizations;
- Work with the Greentown Community team to facilitate cross-community connections, ensuring our members are collaborating and connecting with each other as often as possible;
- Serve as a first point of contact for Greentown Houston startup members to address the needs of this community, often liaising with other Greentown team members;
- Day-to-day management of, engagement with, and strategic planning for the Houston member community in partnership with Greentown Houston and HQ teams;

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- Support the recruitment, evaluation, support, and onboarding of new members;
 - Support onboarding of new member companies; introduce all new Houston member company employees to our community's policies, procedures and guidelines
 - Support ongoing maintenance of our intranet and other member communications channels (e.g., Slack);
 - Assist with the creation, localization, and distribution of Greentown Houston member resources and benefits;
 - Lead regular tours through Greentown Houston for prospective member startups and other visitors; and
 - Assist with the administration of community surveys, especially for the Houston member community.

Events & Marketing Coordination

- Spearhead event planning and execution of programming for both community and external events in collaboration with the Greentown Houston and HQ teams;
- Collaborate with the Greentown marketing and communications team to ensure effective and consistent messaging, collateral, and promotion of all events;
- Develop marketing content, including prose, photos, and videos, for social media channels, website, and newsletters to highlight the Houston ecosystem, Greentown Houston and its startup members.

A hard-working, organized, and enthusiastic individual. You're driven with an entrepreneurial spirit. You're resourceful, creative, collaborative, and have a knack for connecting people. You enjoy working on teams but also thrive when assigned individual projects. You have a keen ability to manage multiple projects and change priorities in stride. You have experience with and genuinely enjoy working at a startup or within a startup ecosystem, and you're passionate about building community.

- At least two years working to foster community in some capacity (professionally or personally);

- Experience with project management, time management, event management, and customer service;

- Experience in the cleantech, climate action, or environmental industry is a plus;
- Strong public speaking skills; and
- An interest in learning on-the-job, a can-do attitude, and comfort in being pushed outside of your comfort zone.
