



Job Title: Director, Northeast Massachusetts

Job Level: Full-time (Exempt)

FORGE is a 501(c)3 nonprofit on a mission to **help startups on the journey from physical prototype to commercialization and impact at scale**. We work with a broad range of startups and innovators with physical products across sectors including robotics, medical devices, cleantech, agriculture, advanced materials, and more, preparing to manufacture and then making right-fit connections to the regional supply chain. The goal is to break down barriers to scale, and the numbers speak for themselves: the 350+ startups we have helped to date boast an incredible survival rate of over 90%, resulting in impactful products making it to market, as well as over \$30 million in known contracts and purchase orders.

This role will lead the new FORGE Merrimack Valley Office, based in Lowell, which will anchor engagement in Northeast Massachusetts and drive economic value to the regional manufacturing ecosystem. In practice, the role requires a convener and connector who is strategic and adept at both building and maintaining strong relationships. The successful applicant will be someone who takes strong ownership, will raise the profile of FORGE in the region, and has passion for the work.

This is a full-time position that is primarily located in Lowell, MA, and requires travel throughout Northeastern MA and to Headquarters in Somerville. The position is grant funded for two years and will continue beyond based on successful fundraising efforts. The role will report to the FORGE Executive Director and work with a regional advisory council made up of local leaders and experts to tailor strategy and activities to the region.

Major responsibilities of the role include:

- Lead FORGE's presence in Northeast MA: build rapport, credibility, and connections with regional manufacturers and stakeholders
- Leverage and engage expertise within regional advisory board to ensure that regional needs are identified and met
- Drive regional engagement including planning and executing events and visibility opportunities
- Grow relationships with manufacturers in the Northeast MA area to address the needs of our startups and to grow our sponsorship pipeline
- Gather, document, and summarize regional stakeholder data, testimonials and success stories, including ensuring integrity of related data sets in our CRM system
- Synthesize information to develop new and targeted programming as well as to assist in the preparation of materials for submission to granting agencies and funders
- Represent FORGE through attendance at ecosystem events and public speaking engagements

A relationship-oriented, hard-working, organized, and enthusiastic individual. You're driven with an entrepreneurial spirit. You're resourceful, collaborative, and have a knack for connecting people. You enjoy working on teams but also thrive taking on individual projects. You're personable and have a unique ability to connect with people and forge meaningful relationships. You have a keen ability to manage multiple projects and change priorities in stride. You genuinely enjoy working in the innovation-oriented startup ecosystem, and you're passionate about the value of local



manufacturing, building community, and driving impact in the Merrimack Valley region and Northeast Massachusetts.
